Inhalt und Ziele		
Kursbeschreibung: The course, offered in English, introduces students to the theoretical concepts and practical aspects of conflict resolution. The focus is put on international disputes. The course addresses both the issues and sources of conflict and discusses the principal methods of conflict management. The current features and dilemmas of conflict resolution will be dealt with in some detail. Case studies will play a major part in the course programme.		
Ziele: The main goal of the course is to familiarize participants with the key issues of conflict resolution in the international context. The objective is to stimulate an active response from the student body by resorting to group simulations of conflict situations. Cases of international conflicts will be studied with a view to exploring the best avenues for their peaceful resolution.
